#### Redding Type S Match Full Length Die Set



Titanium Nitride or Steel Bushings. TiNi are \$50 a piece and Steel \$9. Cases do not require lubricant on outside of the neck, Steel do. Please see [Sizing Chart](#). Sizes are determined by loading a projectile into the case and measuring the outside neck diameter. The bushing size is 1/1000<sup>th</sup> of an inch smaller than this measurement.

### **Recommendations**

These recommendations are supplied from experience in using them for reloading ammunition for sport and precision rifles. These reloading results have been compared with ammunition that has been reloaded using Benchrest equipment in the same precision rifles with match grade chambers. There was no noticeable improvement using the equipment above. If the reloader has a custom cut chamber then custom dies using the same chamber reamer would have to be produced for the best results. Please consult your reloading manual before any reloading is to be done and always start at the minimum charge weight at all times as chambers sizes, barrel lengths, case make and temperatures vary from reloading manual test specifications.
